SENATE BILL NO. 2123
(Judiciary Committee)
(At the request of the State Department of Health)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 32-03.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to liability for providing emergency medical aid.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 32-03.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

32-03.1-05. Exceptions. This chapter ~~shall~~ does not encompass ~~any~~ a person who, at the time of the emergency, was employed expressly or actually for the purpose of providing emergency medical aid to humans, either within or outside of a hospital or other place or vehicle with medical equipment, for emergency medical aid or other assistance rendered in the regular course of their employment. Such persons and their employers ~~shall be~~ are liable for their acts and omissions in rendering emergency medical aid in the regular course of their employment, according to the prevailing law in this state ~~in existence on July 1, 1987.~~
