- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 39-13-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to tourist-oriented directional signs.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-13-09 of the 1999 Supplement
  to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 1. In this section:
- a. "Tourist-oriented directional sign" means a sign providing identification of and
  directional information for tourist-related businesses, services, or activities <u>a</u>
  tourist-oriented business, service, or activity.
- 10b."Tourist-related business, service, or activity" means rural agricultural11business and tourism attractions, including recreation, historical sites, festival12and cultural events, lodging and food services which are singularly and13uniquely related to historical, cultural, or recreational tourist attractions, and14guide services, a business, including a seasonal agricultural products
- 15 business; service; or activity the major portion the income or visitors of which
- 16 is derived during the normal business season from motorists not residing in
- 17 <u>the immediate area of the business, service, or activity;</u> but does not include
  18 any business operated under a franchise agreement.
