1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 53-06.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the limit on wagers in the game twenty-one under the games of chance laws.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 53-06.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **53-06.1-10. Twenty-one.** No money may be used as a wager. The organization shall  
7 provide playing chips of various denominations to players. The maximum limit per wager may  
8 be set by the organization at not more than ~~five~~ twenty-five dollars and wagers in increments of  
9 one dollar must be accepted up to the maximum limit. A player may not play more than two  
10 hands at the same time. Only the player actually playing a hand may place a wager on any  
11 hand. Each player plays the player's hand against the dealer's hand. Any requirement to pool  
12 tips is within the sole discretion of each organization. Except for a site that has twenty-one  
13 gross proceeds averaging less than ten thousand dollars per quarter, an organization may not  
14 conduct twenty-one at the site with wagers exceeding two dollars unless the organization has  
15 first installed video surveillance equipment as required by rules and the equipment is approved  
16 by the attorney general.
