## 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 53-06.1-07.2 of the North Dakota Century

2 Code, relating to conduct of poker under the games of chance laws.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 53-06.1-07.2 of the North Dakota Century Code 5 is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **53-06.1-07.2.** Poker. Poker may be conducted on not more than two occasions per 7 year by a licensed organization in tournament format or through games against the house. An 8 organization may supply the dealer. The maximum single bet is one dollar. Not more than 9 three raises, of not more than one dollar each, may be made among all the players in each 10 round of bets. An organization shall assess each player in a tournament a fee not to exceed 11 two dollars per one-half hour of playing time, collected in advance. A fee may be charged each 12 player for entry into a tournament for prizes and this fee may be in place of or in addition to the 13 fee assessable at one-half hour intervals. Games against the house must base the player's 14 return on a predetermined pay schedule. Money may not be used as a wager. The 15 organization shall provide playing chips of various denominations to players. The maximum 16 limit per wager may be set by the organization at not more than twenty-five dollars and wagers 17 in increments of one dollar must be accepted up to the maximum limit. An organization may not 18 conduct poker at a site unless the organization has first installed video surveillance equipment 19 as required by rules and the equipment is approved by the attorney general.
