## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
  - Antitrust revolving fund. Notwithstanding section 54-12-18, the attorney general shall deposit all moneys collected as attorneys' fees and as civil penalties from the enforcement of antitrust actions by the antitrust division with the state treasurer who shall deposit these moneys in the antitrust fund in the state treasury. Moneys in the antitrust fund must be appropriated to the attorney general for enforcement of antitrust laws.
- SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
  general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much
  of the sum as may be necessary, to the attorney general for the purpose of enforcing antitrust
  laws, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.
