- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-40.3-05 of the North Dakota Century Code
- 2 or in the alternative to amend and reenact section 15.1-31-05 of the North Dakota Century
- 3 Code, relating to the transportation of students participating in open enrollment.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, section 15-40.3-05 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **15-40.3-05. Open enrollment Transportation.** A school district of residence may
- 9 provide transportation to a student participating in open enrollment. If a school district of
- 10 residence does not provide transportation to a student participating in open enrollment,
- 11 transportation may be provided by the admitting district, and the may petition the board of the
- 12 <u>student's school district of residence for permission to transport the student. If written</u>
- 13 permission is granted, the admitting district may transport the student. The admitting district is
- 14 then entitled to state payments for the transportation of that student.
- 15 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-31-05 of the North Dakota Century Code as
- 16 created by House Bill No. 1045, as approved by the fifty-seventh legislative assembly, is
- 17 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **15.1-31-05. Open enrollment Transportation.** A school district of residence may
- 19 provide transportation to a student participating in open enrollment. If a school district of
- 20 residence does not provide transportation to a student participating in open enrollment,
- 21 transportation may be provided by the admitting district, and the may petition the board of the
- 22 <u>student's school district of residence for permission to transport the student. If written</u>
- 23 permission is granted, the admitting district may transport the student. The admitting district is
- then entitled to state payments for the transportation of that student.
