- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-47 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code or in the alternative to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-18 of the
- 3 North Dakota Century Code, relating to teacher unavailability.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to chapter 15-41 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Teacher unavailability - Assistance by qualified individuals.

- 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, if a school district is unable to employ as a high school teacher an individual who meets the requirements of section 15-41-25, the school district may contract with an individual for the provision of teaching services in a particular course area or field if the individual holds a graduate degree in the course area or field to be taught and has at least ten years' work experience in the course area or field to be taught.
- 2. An individual employed under this section has the same legal authority and status as a licensed teacher employed by the district.
- 3. The employment of an individual under this section does not affect the accreditation or approval status of the school in which the individual teaches.
- 4. For purposes of this section, the board of a school district is deemed to have been unable to employ a qualified teacher if:
  - The board put forth a good-faith effort to recruit and retain a qualified licensed teacher for the position before the beginning of the most recent school year;
    and
  - b. The board was unable to find a qualified licensed teacher willing to accept the position.

**SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 15.1-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Teacher unavailability - Assistance by qualified individuals.

- 1.
