1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-09-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the state electrical board membership.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-09-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

6 43-09-02. State electrical board - Members - Terms of office - Vacancies. The 7 state electrical board must consist consists of five six members appointed by the governor for a 8 term of five years with their the terms of office so arranged that one term and only one term 9 expires no more than two terms expire on June thirtieth of each year. One member Two 10 members of the board shall represent the public and may not be directly associated with the 11 electrical industry. The board must include a master electrician who is a contractor, a 12 journeyman electrician, a consumer member of a rural electric cooperative, and a person an 13 individual associated with an investor-owned utility. A member of the board shall qualify 14 gualifies by taking the oath of office required of civil officers and shall hold his holds office until 15 his the member's successor is appointed and qualified. The governor shall fill any vacancy by 16 appointment for the unexpired term of office.
