- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 8-02-08 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to safety standards for passenger contract carriers; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 8-02-08 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 8-02-08. Safety standards for passenger contract carriers Penalty.
- The highway patrol shall establish minimum safety standards for passenger
 contract carriers transporting fewer than fifteen passengers. The safety standards
- 9 must include provisions for driver qualifications; motor vehicle inspection,
- 10 maintenance, and repair; hours of service; drug and alcohol testing; and insurance.
- 11 Insurance safety standards must include a minimum combined single limit
- 12 coverage of four million dollars per occurrence for bodily injury liability, property
- 13 <u>damage liability, and uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage. Coverage</u>
 14 <u>may be satisfied through a primary or an excess policy.</u>
- <u>15</u> <u>2.</u> The highway patrol shall issue a permit to a passenger contract carrier transporting
 <u>16</u> fewer than fifteen passengers which provides proof of compliance with the safety
 17 standards.
- 18 <u>3.</u> <u>A person may not engage in the business of a passenger contract carrier</u>
- transporting fewer than fifteen passengers without obtaining and displaying in each
 vehicle a permit issued under this section.
- <u>4.</u> In this section, "contract carrier" means a person engaged in the business of
 carrying passengers for hire and in that business does not operate on a fixed route.
 The term does not include a person who makes a single daily round trip to
- 24 commute to and from work, a person transporting only schoolchildren and

1		teachers, a person operating ambulance or funeral services, a person who on
