3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-12-05 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 54-12-05. Biennial report.
- The attorney general shall submit a biennial report to the governor and the
 secretary of state in accordance with section 54-06-04. The report must state
 provide:
- 101.a.The number, character, condition, and result A summary of the types of the11actions prosecuted or defended by the attorney general in on behalf of the12state.
- 13 2. b. The <u>aggregate</u> cost of prosecuting or defending cach action <u>actions on behalf</u>
 14 <u>of the state</u>.
- 15 3. <u>c.</u> The amount of fines and penalties collected.
- 16 <u>2.</u> The attorney general also shall direct attention to any defect in the practical 17 operations of the law relating to revenue and criminal offenses, and shall suggest 18 amendments and changes as in the attorney general's judgment are necessary to 19 subserve the public interest.
