HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3013

A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the designation of highways in
the state highway system and the county road system.
WHEREAS, there are approximately 106,514 miles of roadway in the state of North
Dakota, the largest portion of which are township roads at 56,566 miles; and
WHEREAS, the state highway system is limited to 7,456 miles and 7,378 miles are
designated as in the system; and
WHEREAS, the county road system is limited to 22,500 miles and 10,145 miles are
designated as in the system; and
WHEREAS, adequate funding for highways in this state is essential to the major
industry in this state including agriculture and tourism;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
That the Legislative Council study the designation of highways in the state highway
system and the county road system; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
