

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3029

1 A concurrent resolution designating United States Highway 83 through the state of North
2 Dakota as the "Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway".

3 **WHEREAS**, United States Highway 83 extends from the Mexican border at Brownsville,
4 Texas, to the Canadian border near Westhope, North Dakota, across the states of Texas,
5 Oklahoma, Kansas, Nebraska, South Dakota, and North Dakota; and

6 **WHEREAS**, many veterans have fought bravely and courageously in foreign wars for
7 which the residents of this state owe a debt of gratitude; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Nebraska has designated United States Highway 83 through that state as
9 the "Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway"; and

10 **WHEREAS**, North Dakota can join Nebraska and lead the way in honoring the sacrifice
11 of veterans of foreign wars; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the six states in the nation's mid-section through which United States
13 Highway 83 runs may consider the designation "Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway";

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
15 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

16 That in honor of the veterans of foreign wars, United States Highway 83 through the
17 state of North Dakota is designated as the "Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway".
