1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the financial impact of credit

2 card fees imposed on public institutions of higher education and the social effects of credit card3 debt on young adults.

WHEREAS, North Dakota State University reported it incurred credit card fees for
accepting payments by credit cards exceeding \$95,000 in the year 2000 and there are 10 other
state-funded universities with credit card fee expenses in this state; and

WHEREAS, revenue acquired from tuition and fees, room and board, telephone, and
other miscellaneous expenses at North Dakota public institutions of higher education in the year
2000 was \$4,785,304, in which 97.38 percent of collected revenue was paid by credit card
transactions; and

WHEREAS, the state of Kansas and its Board of Regents banned the use of credit
cards after reporting that the taxpayer was subsidizing an estimated \$850,000 per year; and

WHEREAS, in addition to any financial impact credit card fees may be imposing on our
state's economy, there also may be a social impact on the students, regressing their

15 opportunities for future growth due to credit card debt; and

WHEREAS, with the increase of combined credit card and student loan debt, more
students may be dropping out of school without a degree and more students may be leaving the
state to seek higher paying jobs; and

WHEREAS, a detailed study of the financial impact of credit card fees could determine
the financial burdens on North Dakota public institutions of higher education and North Dakota
taxpayers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Legislative Council study the financial impact of credit card fees imposed on public institutions of higher education and the social effects of credit card debt on young Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly

- 3 recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations,
