1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state board for

2 vocational and technical education.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 7 other income, to the state board for vocational and technical education for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of its various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and 9 ending June 30, 2003, as follows: 10 \$2,946,750 Salaries and wages 11 596,147 Operating expenses 12 60,000 Equipment 13 Grants 22,920,288 14 Adult farm management 525,760 15 Work force training 1,350,000 16 Postsecondary education vocational grants 357,452 17 Total all funds \$28,756,397 18 Less estimated income 14,887,742 19 Total general fund appropriation \$13,868,655 20 SECTION 2. WORK FORCE TRAINING FUNDS - DISTRIBUTION. The line item

21 entitled work force training in section 1 of this Act is to be distributed by the state board for

22 vocational and technical education, as follows:

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002, the state
 board for vocational and technical education shall distribute up to a total of

- \$675,000 pursuant to the business plan approved by the state board of higher
 education for each institution of higher education assigned primary responsibility
 for work force training.
- 4 To be eligible to receive state funding for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, 2. 5 and ending June 30, 2003, each institution of higher education assigned primary 6 responsibility for work force training must provide, prior to July 1, 2002, certification 7 to the workforce development division of the department of commerce that at least 8 75 percent of the regional funds included in the approved business plan for the 9 biennium have been received, or are pledged to be received, prior to June 30, 10 2003. These funds may not be distributed to an institution of higher education 11 assigned primary responsibility for work force training until the workforce 12 development division notifies the state board for vocational and technical 13 education that the institution has met the requirements of this subsection. 14 3. Any funds appropriated by the fifty-seventh legislative assembly for work force
- training which as of January 1, 2003, are not distributed pursuant to subsections 1
 and 2 of this section may be distributed by the state board for vocational and
 technical education for grants to secondary and postsecondary vocational and
 technical education programs for equipment, training, or other one-time
 expenditures.
