3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from other income, to the 7 information technology department for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the information 8 technology department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003, as 9 follows: 10 Salaries and wages \$25,985,352 11 36,076,824 **Operating expenses**
