1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for capital projects of various state departments

2 and institutions; to provide an appropriation for state facility energy improvement capital

3 projects of various state departments and institutions; to authorize the industrial commission

4 and the state board of higher education to issue and sell bonds for capital projects; to provide

5 an appropriation; and to declare an emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS. The industrial commission, acting as the
North Dakota building authority, shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this
section, hereby declared to be in the public interest, through the issuance of evidences of
indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending
June 30, 2003. The proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other available funds are
hereby appropriated during the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003, for

17 The industrial commission shall issue evidences of indebtedness under this section with 18 the condition that lease rental payments need not begin until July 1, 2003. This authority of the 19 industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness ends June 30, 2003, but the 20 industrial commission may continue to exercise all other powers granted to it under chapter 21 54-17.2 and this Act and to comply with any covenants entered into before that date. 22 Grand total special funds appropriation \$12,852,000

23 SECTION 2. BOND ISSUANCE REPAYMENT RESPONSIBILITY. Of the total
 24 amount of evidences of indebtedness issued under the provisions of section 1 of this Act, a

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1 total of \$6,656,000 must be available from nongeneral fund sources to assist in the retirement 2 of the evidences of indebtedness issued for the project costs associated with the construction 3 of the projects authorized by this Act: 4 \$1,755,000 State department of health 5 Job service North Dakota 2,302,000 6 2,599,000 Minot state university 7 SECTION 3. STATE FACILITY ENERGY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT 8 **AUTHORIZATIONS.** The industrial commission, acting as the North Dakota building authority, 9 shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this section, which are described in 10 the report filed by the division of community services of the office of management and budget 11 with the governor, dated August 30, 2000, and which are hereby declared to be in the public 12 interest, through the issuance of evidences of indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2 and section 13 54-44.5-08, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003. The 14 proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other available funds are hereby appropriated during the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003, for the following 15 16 projects: 17 Department of transportation Headquarters building \$352,600 18 North Dakota state university Sundry projects 296,348 19 University of North Dakota 3,990,785 Sundry projects

The authority of the industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness under this section ends June 30, 2003, but the industrial commission may continue to exercise all other powers granted to it under chapter 54-17.2, section 54-44.5-08, and this Act, and comply with any covenants entered into before that date.

25 **SECTION 4. LOCAL RESPONSIBILITY - APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated 26 from local or other funds, the sum of \$1,300,000 to the state college of science for the purpose 27 of providing the required local match for the student union renovation project, for the biennium 28 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.

SECTION 5. BOND ISSUANCE - PURPOSES - APPROPRIATION. The state board
 of higher education, in accordance with chapter 15-55, may issue and sell self-liquidating,
 tax-exempt bonds in an amount not exceeding \$17,500,000. Bonds issued pursuant to this

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- 1 section are not a general obligation of the state of North Dakota. The bonds may be issued,
- 2 and the proceeds are appropriated, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending
- 3 June 30, 2003, for the purpose of financing the following capital projects:

4	University of North Dakota - Memorial student union renovation	\$3,500,000
5	North Dakota state university - Residence hall construction	8,000,000
6	North Dakota state university - Minard hall renovation	3,000,000
7	North Dakota state college of science - Student union renovation	2,000,000
8	North Dakota state college of science - Parking lot improvements	1,000,000

- 9 Any unexpended balance resulting from the proceeds of the bonds must be placed in a sinking
- 10 fund to be used for the retirement of the bonds.
- 11 **SECTION 6. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
