5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to 7 chapter 15-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

17	purpose of administering a teacher mentor program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001,				
18	and ending June 30, 2003.
