- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to restrictions on guides and outfitters; and to amend and reenact
- 3 subsection 17 of section 20.1-02-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the powers
- 4 of the director of the game and fish department.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Guides and outfitters - Rules - Restrictions. An individual may not:

- Act as a guide or outfitter or advertise or otherwise represent to the public that the individual is a guide or outfitter without first securing a license in accordance with this title and the applicable rules of the director;
- Act as a certified guide or outfitter or advertise or otherwise represent to the public that the individual meets the qualifications of being certified without first complying with section 20.1-03-36;
- 3. Act as a hunting guide or outfitter on land owned by or leased by the department;
 - 4. Act as a hunting guide or outfitter on land on which the department has obtained an easement or has entered into a lease or other agreement, granting the right of public access to that land for hunting or recreational use;
- 5. Have in that person's immediate possession, a firearm or other weapon declared legal by the governor's proclamation while afield with a person employing that individual as a hunting guide or outfitter;

1	<u>7.</u>	Utilize land under control of the United States government before obtaining the
2		proper permits required by the government agency responsible for the area in
3		which that person intends to operate as a hunting guide or outfitter; or
4	<u>8.</u>	Willfully and substantially misrepresent that person's facilities, prices, equipment,
5		services, or hunting or fishing opportunities as a guide or outfitter.
6	SEC	CTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 17 of section 20.1-02-05 of the 1999
7	Supplemen	t to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
8	17.	Subject to the provisions of chapter 28-32, adopt rules for the licensing of guides or
9		outfitters, and may require records and reports as the director determines
10		necessary. The director may, after due hearing as provided in chapter 28-32,
11		revoke or refuse to renew the license of $\frac{1}{2}$ person who violates the rules or fails
12		to provide the records and reports. Any person who acts as a guide or outfitter
13		without a license is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
