**SENATE BILL NO. 2108**

Introduced by

(At the request of the Department of Public Instruction)

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 15-40.1-06 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code or in the alternative to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 15.1-27-02 of  
3 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to late filing of reports to the department of public  
4 instruction.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective,  
7 subsection 4 of section 15-40.1-06 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code  
8 is amended and reenacted as follows:

9 4. ~~No~~ A school district may not receive foundation payments beyond the October  
10 payment unless the following reports have been filed with the superintendent of  
11 public instruction:

- 12 a. Annual average daily membership report.  
13 b. Annual school district financial report.  
14 c. The September tenth fall enrollment report.  
15 d. The personnel report forms for certified and noncertified employees.

16 If all of these reports are filed by the following February first, the school district may  
17 receive all of the foundation payments withheld. If all of these reports are filed at a  
18 later date, the school district is entitled to receive only the previous four months in  
19 foundation payments.

20 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 15.1-27-02 of the North Dakota  
21 Century Code as created by House Bill No. 1045, as approved by the fifty-seventh legislative  
22 assembly, is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 1           1.    The superintendent of public instruction may not forward state aid payments to a  
2                    school district beyond the October payment unless the district has filed the  
3                    following with the superintendent:  
4                    a.    An annual average daily membership report.  
5                    b.    An annual school district financial report.  
6                    c.    The September tenth fall enrollment report.  
7                    d.    The personnel report forms for licensed and nonlicensed employees.  
8                    If all of these reports are filed by the following February first, the school district may  
9                    receive all of the state aid payments withheld. If all of these reports are filed at a  
10                   later date, the school district is entitled to receive only the previous four months in  
11                   state aid payments.
