4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 15-10-19.1 of the 1999

5 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 2. A "resident student" for tuition purposes means:

7	a.	A person less than eighteen years of age whose guardian, custodial parent,
8		or parents are legal residents of this state and have resided in this state for
9		twelve months, or a dependent child whose custodial parent moved into the
10		state with the intent to establish legal residency for a period of years within the
11		last twelve months immediately prior to the beginning of the academic term;
12	b.	A person of age eighteen or over who is a legal resident of this state and has
13		resided in this state after reaching age eighteen for twelve months
14		immediately prior to the beginning of the academic term;
15	C.	A person who graduated from a North Dakota high school within six years of
16		the beginning of the academic term;
17	d.	A full-time active duty member of the armed forces assigned to a military
18		installation in this state;

e. A spouse or dependent of a full-time active duty member of the armed forces
assigned to a military installation in this state, a dependent or of an instructor
who lives and teaches in employee of any institution of higher education in
this state, and a spouse of any other resident for tuition purposes; and
