1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to initiative and referendum petitions.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-01-09 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

16.1-01-09. Initiative, referendum, or recall petitions - Signature - Form -

- qualified electors of the state, political subdivision, or district in which the official is
   to be recalled who are sponsoring the recall.
- 5. No petition shall be circulated under the authority of article III of the Constitution of North Dakota by a person who is less than eighteen years of age, nor shall the affidavit called for by subsection 3 be executed by a person who is less than eighteen years of age at the time of signing. All petitions circulated under the authority of the constitution and of this section must be circulated in their entirety. A petition may not include a statement of intent or similar explanatory information.
- 9 6. When signed petitions are delivered to the secretary of state, the chairperson of
  10 the sponsoring committee shall submit to the secretary of state an affidavit stating
  11 that to the best of that person's knowledge, the petitions contain at least the
  12 required number of signatures.
- An initiative or referendum petition may be submitted to the secretary of state until
  midnight of the day designated as the deadline for submitting the petition.
- An initiative petition may be circulated for one year from the date it is approved for
   circulation by the secretary of state.
