FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Senate Amendments ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1305

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 53-06.1-07.2 of the North Dakota Century

2 Code, relating to conduct of poker under the games of chance laws.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 53-06.1-07.2 of the North Dakota Century Code 5 is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **53-06.1-07.2.** Poker. Poker may be conducted on not more than two occasions per 7 year month by a licensed organization in traditional format, in tournament format, or through 8 games against the house. An organization may supply the dealer. The maximum single bet is 9 one dollar. Not more than three raises, of not more than one dollar each, may be made among 10 all the players in each round of bets. An organization shall assess each player in a tournament 11 a fee not to exceed two dollars per one-half hour of playing time, collected in advance. A fee 12 may be charged each player for entry into a tournament for prizes and this fee may be in place 13 of or in addition to the fee assessable at one-half hour intervals. Games against the house 14 must base the player's return on a predetermined pay schedule. Money may not be used as a 15 wager. The organization shall provide playing chips of various denominations to players. The 16 maximum limit per wager may be set by the organization at not more than twenty-five dollars 17 and wagers in increments of one dollar must be accepted up to the maximum limit. An 18 organization may not conduct poker at a site unless the organization has first installed video 19 surveillance equipment as required by rules and the equipment is approved by the attorney 20 general.
