- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-33 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the duties of a trustee of a life insurance trust; and to provide for

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 26.1-33 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
- Life insurance policy acquisition, ownership or retention by trust Duties of trustee. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the duties of a trustee regarding the acquisition, retention, or ownership of a life insurance policy upon the life of any one or more of the grantor of the trust, the grantor's spouse, children, grandchildren, or parents include a duty of loyalty and fair dealing, but do not include a duty to:
- 1. Determine whether any life insurance policy in the trust is or remains a proper investment;
 - 2. Exercise a policy option, right, or privilege available under a life insurance policy; or
- 15 3. Diversify the investment.

- A trustee is not liable to the beneficiaries under the trust instrument or to any other person for a loss that is claimed to result from the absence of these duties.
- SECTION 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICATION OF ACT. Unless the trust instrument specifically provides otherwise, this Act applies retroactively to any trust established before August 1, 2000, and to any life insurance policy acquired by a trustee before August 1, 2000.
