- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to title 39 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to theft of motor fuels; to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 39-06-32 of
- 3 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to authority of the department of transportation to
- 4 suspend driving privileges; and to provide a penalty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to title 39 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 Nonpayment for motor fuels Penalty. A person who leaves the premises of an
- 9 establishment at which motor fuel offered for retail sale was dispensed into the fuel tank of a
- 10 motor vehicle by driving away in that motor vehicle without having made due payment or
- 11 authorized charge for the motor fuel dispensed is guilty of an infraction for conviction of the first
- 12 offense and a class B misdemeanor for conviction of a second or subsequent offense. The
- 13 department shall:

- 14 <u>I. Upon a person's second conviction, suspend the person's driving privileges for six</u>
 months; and
- 16 <u>2.</u> Upon a person's third or subsequent conviction, suspend the person's driving
 privileges for one year.
- 18 As used in this section, "conviction" means a final conviction without regard to whether
- 19 <u>sentence was suspended or deferred or probation was granted after the conviction.</u> Forfeiture
- 20 of bail, bond, or collateral deposited to secure a defendant's appearance in court, which
- 21 forfeiture has not been vacated, is equivalent to conviction.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-06-32 of the 1999 Supplement
- 23 to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 1. Commission of an offense for which mandatory revocation <u>or suspension</u> of license
- 2 is required upon conviction.
