- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to title 39 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to theft of motor fuels; and to provide a penalty.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to title 39 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Nonpayment for motor fuels - Penalty.

- 1. For a theft offense in violation of chapter 12.1-23 which involves a person who leaves the premises of an establishment at which motor fuel is offered for retail sale after motor fuel was dispensed into the fuel tank of a motor vehicle that that person drove away without having made due payment or authorized charge for the motor fuel dispensed, the court may:
  - Upon a person's second conviction, order the suspension of the person's driving privileges for up to three months; and
  - b. Upon a person's third or subsequent conviction, order the suspension of the person's driving privileges for up to six months.
- As used in this section, "conviction" means a final conviction without regard to
  whether sentence was suspended or deferred or probation was granted after the
  conviction. Forfeiture of bail, bond, or collateral deposited to secure a defendant's
  appearance in court, which forfeiture has not been vacated, is equivalent to
  conviction.
