## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3059

1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study small claims court.
2	WHEREAS, small claims court provides inexpensive access to informal proceedings to
3	resolve minor claims for the recovery of money or for the cancellation of an agreement; and
4	WHEREAS, an election by the plaintiff to proceed in small claims court is irrevocable
5	and the plaintiff waives the right of appeal; and
6	WHEREAS, a defendant who elects not to remove the action from small claims court
7	waives the right of appeal; and
8	WHEREAS, an appeal mechanism has been requested by the legal and business
9	communities and by the public; and
10	WHEREAS, because of the restrictions on the right to appeal, many residents are
11	bypassing small claims court because of the uncertainty of a fair judgment and the finality of
12	decisions, thereby burdening the resources of district court with minor disputes;
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
14	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
15	That the Legislative Council study small claims court; and
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
17	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
18	the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly.
