## FIRST READING OF SENATE BILLS

Sens. Lyson, Kringstad and Reps. Carlisle, Drovdal, Rennerfeldt introduced:

**SB 2177:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the display of the Ten Commandments.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Education Committee**.

Sens. Lyson, O'Connell, Stenehjerm and Reps. Carlisle, Drovdal, Rennerfeldt introduced:

**SB 2178:** A BILL for an Act to enter the interstate wildlife violator compact; and to provide a penalty.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

Sens. Traynor, Lee, Watne and Reps. Delmore, Rennerfeldt introduced:

**SB 2179:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 47-19 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the authority of North Dakota notaries to act in other states; to amend and reenact section 44-06-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the performance of notarial acts; and to declare an emergency.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sens. Holmberg, Freborg, O'Connell and Reps. Carlisle, Delmore, R. Kelsch introduced:

**SB 2180:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-39.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to retired teachers returning to teaching under the teachers' fund for retirement; to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 15-39.1-09 and section 15-39.1-19.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to assessments and resumption of teaching under the teachers' fund for retirement; and to provide an expiration date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Education Committee**.

Sens. Traynor, Krebsbach, Stenehjem and Reps. Glassheim, Hawken introduced:

**SB 2181:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 13 of section 57-39.2-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to limitations on the sales tax exemption for rentals of motor vehicles; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Sens. Solberg, O'Connell, Tollefson and Reps. Boucher, Gunter, Nelson introduced:

**SB 2182:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-04-22 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to prescriptive water rights.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

The Senate stood adjourned pursuant to Senator Christmann's motion.
