Both nonresident hunting and nonresident fishing license fees are increased and the small game and waterfowl hunting license structure is changed. With this legislation the cost of the license package for nonresidents who hunt both upland game and waterfowl will change from the current \$95 fee to \$140. The fees for nonresidents who hunt only waterfowl will remain at the current \$95 level. The fees for nonresidents who hunt upland game, but not waterfowl will increase from \$85 to \$95.

The total increase in hunting license revenue is estimated to be about \$200,000 per year. The increase in nonresident fishing license revenue will be about \$160,000 per year. The fishing license increase will apply only for the second year of the 2001-2003 biennium.
