This bill provides for a youth smoking prevention commission established in the office of the governor. The commission would be made up of 13 members of which 10 would be appointed by the governor. The purpose of the commission would be to develop a state plan for youth smoking prevention. The commission would also establish and implement a treatment plan. The commission would also provide grants for youth smoking prevention programs.
