Section 9 of SB 2019 extends the 7-cent reduction in refunds of tax for fuel used for agricultural purposes. That additional one-cent withheld will generate approx. \$278,000 during the 01-03 bienium, earmarked for ethanol production incentives in the highway distribution fund. (Two cents, or \$556,000 will be available for the agricultural fuel tax fund, and four cents, or \$1,112,000 will go to the agricultural research fund.)
