Campuses anticipate minimal loss in current tuition revenues as a result of currently enrolled students shifting from non-resident to resident tuition status. Although difficult to estimate, we would anticipate that new students currently not enrolled in the NDUS would increase as a result of the expanded "resident definition" for tuition puposes. Thus, we would estimate a net positive gain in tuition revenues over the long-term within the NDUS as new students attend a NDUS campus.

For 2001-2003 biennium, the net estimated increase in tuition revenue systemwide is \$15,000-30,000 (used midpoint \$22,500 above). For 2003-05 the estimated increase in tuition revenue is \$40,000-60,000 (used midpoint of \$50,000 above).
