6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 52-11-01 of the North Dakota

- 8 Job service North Dakota and the The North Dakota national guard are is 1. 9 authorized either jointly or severally to establish an employee retirement programs 10 program by contract with an insurance company, state or national bank and trust 11 company, or an investment company, authorized under the law to do business in 12 this state, the state investment board, or the North Dakota public employees 13 retirement system. Except for a retirement program established under chapter 14 54-52, the North Dakota national guard shall prepare specifications of the terms of 15 the retirement program which must be submitted to not less than three companies 16 or agencies with a request for bids upon the retirement program contracts. After 17 the submission of at least three bids, the adjutant general shall compare the bids, 18 and with the approval of the governor, shall execute a contract for the retirement 19 program with the company or agency submitting the lowest and best bid. Job 20 service North Dakota The public employees retirement system board is authorized 21 to administer the retirement plan established in 1961 and frozen to new entrants in 22 1980, for employees of job service North Dakota.
- 23 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 7 of section 54-52-04 of the North Dakota
