- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-27-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the school district equalization factor.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-27-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-27-05. (Effective through June 30, 2004) School district equalization factor.
- 7 To determine the amount of payments due a school district, the superintendent of public
- 8 instruction shall add the tuition apportionment payments, per student payments, special
- 9 education aid, transportation aid, and teacher compensation payments for which a school
- 10 district is eligible and from that total subtract the following:
  - The product of thirty-two thirty-four mills times the latest available net assessed and equalized valuation of property in the district.
    - The amount by which the unobligated general fund balance of the district on the preceding June thirtieth is in excess of seventy-five percent of its actual expenditures plus twenty thousand dollars.

## 16 (Effective after June 30, 2004) School district equalization factor.

- 1. To determine the amount of payments due a school district, the superintendent of public instruction shall add the tuition apportionment payments, per student payments, special education aid, transportation aid, and teacher compensation payments for which a school district is eligible and from that total subtract the following:
- 1. <u>a.</u> The product of thirty-two thirty-six mills times the latest available net assessed and equalized valuation of property in the district.

- 2. <u>b.</u> The amount by which the unobligated general fund balance of the district on the preceding June thirtieth is in excess of fifty percent of its actual expenditures, plus twenty thousand dollars.
  - 2. Beginning July 1, 2005, and each year thereafter, the number of mills used by the superintendent of public instruction in determining the product required by subdivision a of subsection 1 must be increased by two over the number of mills used in determining the product required by that subdivision the previous year.
