Due to increased costs of metabolic food (formula) provided to individuals with phenylketonuria (PKU) and maple syrup urine disease (MSUD) and the increased progam participation, it is estimated that an increase of \$80,000 will be incurred. The reengrossed bill allows the Department to seek reimbursment from any government program that provides coverage to that individual. For the 01-03 biennium it is estimated that we may collect approximately \$8,000 from other government programs. **Included in the Health Department's appropriation bill SB 2004 is \$80,000 from the community health trust fund**.
