This bill allows the interest earned from the community health trust fund and the water development trust fund to be deposited into the community health trust fund. The interest currently is being deposited into the general fund. According to the budget committee on health care, it is estimated that based on a 4.9 percent interest rate, the July 1, 2001 balance of \$5.2 million in the community health trust fund will generate \$510,000 of interest income per biennium and will remain in the fund. It is estimated that based on a 4.9 percent interest rate, the July 1, 2001 balance of \$3 to \$5 million in the water development trust fund will generate \$900,000 of interest income per biennium and will be transferred from the water development trust fund to the community health trust fund, for a total \$1.41 million of interest income per biennium.
