This bill provides for a tobacco prevention advisory committee established in the office of the governor. The committee would be made up of 12 members. The purpose of the committee would be to develop a state plan for tobacco prevention and dependency treatment which is built on and does not duplicate the existing CDC tobacco grant requirements. The committee would also provide grants for tobacco prevention programs and according to section 9 of this bill. A new line item for tobacco prevention and control was created in the Health Department's appropriation bill SB 2004. This includes funding from the community health trust fund of \$4,700,000 and federal funds from CDC of \$2,369,934 for a total of \$7,069,934 to implement the programs outlined in this bill.
