This bill proposes to increase the annual license fee for auctioneers and auction clerks from \$35 to \$50. This fee was last increased in 1987. Increaseing this fee to \$50 and imposing a \$25 surcharge for renewals that are submitted in an untimely manner would generate additional general fund income of approximately \$19,000 per biennium. The increase was recommended by the State Auditor in a March 2000 audit report.

The \$19,000 projected revenue increase is based on the current number of licensees (approx. 600) times the proposed \$15 increase.
