NORTH DAKOTA WORKERS COMPENSATION 2001 LEGISLATION SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION

BILL DESCRIPTION: Safety Grant Expansion

BILL NO: HB 1163

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: North Dakota Workers Compensation, together with its actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, has reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The proposed legislation expands the funding for safety grants by \$630,000 to approximately \$1.2 million per biennium. The bill also includes \$131,600 and 1 FTE for the administration of the program.

FISCAL IMPACT: The proposed funding adjustment of \$762 thousand will increase administrative costs by 0.5% to 1% of anticipated premium for fiscal year 2001-02. However, NDWC's past successes with other incentive programs suggests that loss cost savings may ultimately off-set the additional costs for the expanded program.
