4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 9 of section 52-09-20 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 7 "Primary insurance benefit" means the sum of the following: 8 (1) Fifty percent of the amount of an individual's average monthly wage if a. 9 the average monthly wage does not exceed seventy-five dollars; or 10 (2) If the average monthly wage exceeds seventy-five dollars, thirty-seven 11 dollars and fifty cents, plus fifteen percent of the amount by which the 12 average monthly wage exceeds seventy-five dollars and does not 13 exceed two hundred fifty dollars; 14 b. One percent of the amount computed under subdivision a, multiplied by the 15 number of years in which two hundred dollars or more of wages were paid to 16 the individual; and 17 C. (1) Effective August 1, 2001 2003, eight hundred twenty-six seventy-nine 18 dollars and sixty-four ninety-six cents; or 19 (2) Effective August 1, 2002 2004, eight hundred fifty-three nine hundred 20 six dollars and thirty sixty-two cents. 21 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the 22 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,800, or so much of 23 the sum as may be necessary, to job service North Dakota for the purpose of paying old-age
