

**SENATE BILL NO. 2052**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 15.1-06-04 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to the school calendar; and to repeal section 15.1-06-02 of the North  
3 Dakota Century Code, relating to mandated school holidays.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 15.1-06-04 of the 1999  
6 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 1. During each school year, a school district shall provide for a school calendar of at  
8 least one hundred eighty days, apportioned as follows:

9 a. One hundred seventy-three full days of instruction;

10 b. ~~Three holidays listed in subdivisions b through j of subsection 1 of section~~  
11 ~~15.1-06-02 and~~ Five days selected by the school board in consultation with  
12 district teachers;

13 e. ~~Two days for the attendance of teachers at the North Dakota education~~  
14 ~~association instructional conference~~ for holidays, continuing education  
15 activities, and school activities; and

16 ~~e.~~ c. Up to two full days during which parent-teacher conferences are held or which  
17 are deemed by the school board to be compensatory time for parent-teacher  
18 conferences held outside regular school hours.

19 **SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Section 15.1-06-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
20 repealed.
