- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-04-21 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the temporary registration of motor vehicles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-04-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

39-04-21. Fees for motor vehicles first registered in state - Temporary

8	<u>1.</u>	When a motor vehicle first becomes subject to registration during the calendar
9		year, the registration fee must be for the remainder of the year prorated on a
10		monthly basis, one-twelfth of the annual registration fee for each calendar month or
11		fraction thereof. Penny adjustments must be carried to the next even dollar.
12	<u>2.</u>	Temporary registrations must be issued in such <u>a</u> manner as is prescribed by the
13		director of the department of transportation. The director shall issue a number
14		plate to an applicant for a temporary registration. The applicant shall display the
15		number plate as otherwise required by this chapter. The fee imposed for a
16		violation of section 39-04-11 as a result of not displaying the plates issued under
17		this subsection must be distributed to the treasurer of the governing body of the
18		law enforcement officer who enforced the temporary registration requirement for
19		deposit as determined by that governing body. In addition to any other fee, a
20		person who violates subdivision c or e of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 shall
21		pay a noncriminal enforcement surcharge of twenty dollars to the treasurer of the
22		governing body of the law enforcement officer who made the arrest.
