- WHEREAS, genetically modified wheat may pose risks of unknown proportions to the state's economy and particularly to the agricultural sector; and
  - **WHEREAS**, a number of countries have restricted the import of genetically modified wheat; and
- WHEREAS, farmers planting genetically modified wheat are facing unknown liability for damage caused to neighboring farmers who are not planting genetically modified wheat or who are involved in organic farming; and
  - **WHEREAS**, an appropriate infrastructure necessary for the segregation of genetically modified wheat is not in place; and
- WHEREAS, technology agreements associated with genetically modified crops tend to result in an increase in farmers' seed costs and a decrease in farmers' ability to propagate seed for their own use;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- That the Legislative Council study issues related to genetically modified wheat, including issues of segregation, liability, economic impact, and agronomic effects; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
