- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 57-38-01.8 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to application of the income tax credit for geothermal, solar, or wind
- 3 energy devices on leased property; and to provide an effective date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 57-38-01.8 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 1. Any taxpayer filing a North Dakota income tax return pursuant to the provisions of this chapter may claim a credit for the cost of a geothermal, solar, or wind energy device installed in a building or on property owned <u>or leased</u> by the taxpayer in North Dakota. The credit provided in this section must be in an amount equal to five percent per year for three years of the actual cost of acquisition and installation of the geothermal, solar, or wind energy device and must be subtracted from any income tax liability of the taxpayer as determined pursuant to the provisions of this chapter.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after December 31, 2000.
