

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3052**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study issues of safety, efficiency,  
2 and cost-effectiveness with respect to school district transportation.

3 **WHEREAS**, both urban and rural school districts are faced with issues regarding the  
4 transportation of students; and

5 **WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that approximately \$36 million will be expended by the state  
6 as transportation reimbursement to school districts during the 2001-03 biennium; and

7 **WHEREAS**, school districts expend local funds as well as moneys provided by the state  
8 for expenditures incurred in the transportation of students; and

9 **WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the students, the school districts, and the  
10 taxpayers of this state that transportation of students be safe, efficient, and cost-effective;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study issues of safety, efficiency, and cost-effectiveness  
14 with respect to school district transportation; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and  
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
17 the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
