1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study issues of safety, efficiency,

2 and cost-effectiveness with respect to school district transportation.

3 WHEREAS, both urban and rural school districts are faced with issues regarding the

4 transportation of students; and

- 5 WHEREAS, it is anticipated that approximately \$36 million will be expended by the state
- 6 as transportation reimbursement to school districts during the 2001-03 biennium; and
- 7 WHEREAS, school districts expend local funds as well as moneys provided by the state
 8 for expenditures incurred in the transportation of students; and
- 9 **WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the students, the school districts, and the
- 10 taxpayers of this state that transportation of students be safe, efficient, and cost-effective;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

12 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 13 That the Legislative Council study issues of safety, efficiency, and cost-effectiveness
- 14 with respect to school district transportation; and
- 15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
- 16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to

17 the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
