HOUSE BILL NO. 1056 (Representatives Eckre, Williams, Weiler) (Senators Thane, Heitkamp, Espegard)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 55 of section 40-05-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to ownership by a municipality of property located outside this state.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 55 of section 40-05-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

55. Real and personal property. To acquire by lease, purchase, gift, condemnation, or other lawful means and to hold in its corporate name for use and control as provided by law, both real and personal property and easements and rights of way within or without the corporate limits <u>or outside this state</u> for all purposes authorized by law or necessary to the exercise of any power granted.
