- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for state funding of county office buildings containing court facilities;
- 2 and to provide an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$2,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the supreme court for the purpose of providing funding for county office building projects, for the period beginning July 1, 2003, and ending
- 9 **SECTION 2. RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF FUNDS.** The supreme court may award 10 funds appropriated under section 1 of this Act subject to the following:
 - The funds may only be used to fund projects for which the plans include the consolidation of a municipal court and the district court into the county office building;
- 14 2. The funds may be used for either new construction or the remodeling of an existing structure;
- 16 3. The amount awarded to any one project may not exceed two million dollars;
 - 4. Local funding of at least fifty percent from other sources; and
- 18 5. At least two of the following three criteria must be met:
- a. A demonstrated growth in caseload by at least ten percent over a five-year
 rolling base period;
- b. A demonstrated growth in judgeships by at least ten percent over a five-year rolling base period; or
- c. A demonstrated space deficiency.
