- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 10-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to securities privacy of information.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 10-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Disclosing nonpublic personal information.

- 1. As used in this section, "customer" means any person that is a resident of or is domiciled in this state and that has transacted or is transacting business with, or has used or is using the services of a person regulated under subsection 2. As used in this section, "affiliate" includes those companies that are related to one another through a management contract in which one company controls the operations of another.
- A dealer, a federal covered adviser, or an investment adviser registered in this
 state and physically located in this state may not disclose a customer's nonpublic
 personal information contrary to the provisions of title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley
 Act [Pub. L. 106-102; 113 Stat. 1436] or contrary to the rules adopted by the
 commissioner under this section.
- 3. The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to implement this section. The rules must provide for a customer opt-in for the sharing of a customer's nonpublic personal information that is not otherwise exempted under federal law.
- 4. This section does not create a private right of action.
