1 A BILL for an Act relating to copies of credit reports by consumer reporting agencies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Consumer reporting agency - Copy of credit report. A consumer reporting agency located in this state, upon the appearance of the consumer at the place of business of the consumer reporting agency during normal business hours, and upon the request of the consumer, shall provide the consumer with a paper copy of the consumer's credit report within ninety minutes of the request. As used in this section, the term "consumer reporting agency" has the same meaning as under section 603(f) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act [Pub. L. 90-321; 15 U.S.C. 1681a(f)]. The consumer reporting agency may not charge the
