1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 23-10-10.1 and 23-10-11 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to procedures and rules of a mobile home park.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 23-10-10.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 23-10-10.1. Requirement of response procedures in certain mobile home parks. 7 The owner of a mobile home park that contains at least ten mobile homes shall establish a 8 procedure for responding to emergencies and complaints by tenants with respect to the mobile 9 home park. The procedure must include the ability to reach a person who has the authority to 10 perform, or direct the performance of, duties imposed on the owner under this chapter. In a 11 mobile home park that contains at least seventy-five units, the person to be reached must 12 reside in the mobile home park. The procedure must be in writing and a copy must be provided 13 to the tenants.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 23-10-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

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23-10-11. Ejection from premises - Peaceable assembly.

171.The owner or manager of a mobile home park, trailer park, or campground may18eject any person from the premises for nonpayment of charges or fees for19accommodations, for a violation of law, for disorderly conduct, for a violation of any20regulation of the department, or for a violation of any reasonable rule of the mobile21home park, trailer park, or campground which is publicly posted within the park or22campground.

23 2. A rule of a mobile home park may not limit a tenant in peaceably meeting or
24 communicating with other tenants at reasonable times and places for the purpose

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- 1 of organizing or informing other tenants on matters relating to mobile home park
- 2 <u>rules, maintenance, leases, or ownership.</u>
